Keep Our Mission Team In Your Prayers this Week

We were all affected by Hurricane Irma last year, but some areas of Florida were hit much harder than we were here in the Bay Area. In Collier County it was determined that 200 homes need full replacement, but funds have not yet been provided for this process, so many people are still living in condemned homes. Some of our students and adults are going to Collier County this week to work with UMCOR (United Methodist Committee on Relief). They will assist in making repairs to ensure that homes are safe, sanitary and secure. Though many of these homes are not viable long term, they are the only option for the people living in them because there is no affordable housing in Collier County for the bottom two tiers of household income. To date, the Collier UMCOR team has hosted over 155 volunteers providing 4,634 hours of repair work on homes in the Everglades, Goodland, Immokalee and East Naples.

The mission team is listed below. Let's keep them, and the people they will be helping, in our prayers all week as they reach out and share Christ's love by serving the people of Collier County.


