Last Sunday we shared the great news that an anonymous member of St. Paul has agreed to match the congregation's gifts up to \$100,000 for the purpose of debt reduction! We've already received a significant amount toward the matching, and are working on reducing our debt in other ways as well. Here are the numbers we shared last Sunday:


