17,000 People receiving food each month from Open Arms

This year Open Arms officially became a Feeding Tampa Bay hub and partnered with the USDA! These partnerships allow us to distribute food to **25** ministries and food pantries all over our community. Together, we are helping feed over **17,000** people each month!

In addition to the backpacks given on Jubilee day, supplies and backpacks were also given to Ponce De Leon Elementary, Largo Middle, Open Arms, Pinellas Academy of Math and Science, and a special needs school. We also supplied about a hundred school uniforms to Ponce!
